Are you and your family prepared?

Experts agree that people have as little as **2 MINUTES** to escape a burning home before it's too late to get out, but many Americans have a false sense of security about surviving a fire.



62% mistakenly believe that they have at least five minutes or more to escape a burning home – more than twice as long as they really may.



18% mistakenly believe they have 10 minutes or more to escape.

You can take these easy steps to increase chances of surviving a fire

1. Make an escape plan

2. Make sure you have working smoke alarms in your home.

3. Practice fire drill, then check your escape time.

Make sure everyone in your home knows these simple rules

"Keep an eye on what you fry." Stay in the kitchen when frying, grilling or using an open flame.



Matches and lighters are locked away.

Large and small appliances are plugged directly into wall outlets.



Never smoke in bed.
